**We are excited to work with your family this summer!** Our goal is to provide comprehensive, one-on-one learning experiences for Sumter County students to learn that creativity is relevant and applicable to everything in their lives. You are invited to a Camp Celebration on **June 9**. Family, friends and CCA supporters will come to celebrate our campers, view and listen to the art made at camp, and have a great time! All campers are required to attend.

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

**Campers are required to attend every session of camp.** Since space in camp is limited to 20 students (10 students between 8 and 12 years of age and 10 students between 13 and 18 years of age), it is important that campers and their families understand that their involvement in summer camp means that another Sumter County student did not get to attend.

If a camper has one unexcused absence, including arrival to camp more than 30 minutes late and leaving more than 30 minutes early, the camper will receive a verbal and written warning that must be signed by a parent or guardian. After any subsequent unexcused absences, the camper will be asked to leave the camp permanently.

Excused absences include sickness and family emergencies (family vacations are not emergencies). Please contact the CCA in advance to report any excused absences.

Due to limited space, the summer camp cannot accommodate any additional youth guests. Parents and guardians are welcome to visit, though campers will be busy pursuing their camp goals and acquiring new creative skills.

## **BEHAVIOR POLICY**

Campers are expected to act with respect, courtesy and consideration toward all members of camp. Acts of violence, real or threatened, bullying, harassment or intimidation of any member of camp will not be tolerated. Swearing, smoking or use of drugs or alcohol at camp will not be tolerated.

All campers are required to stay on CCA grounds during camp hours, including during lunch (see map of Coleman Center grounds in this packet), unless accompanied by a CCA employee or volunteer. Vandalism and theft of property are unacceptable.

No cell phones, including camera phones, or other electronic devices can be on or used during camp hours.
