Juror Wassan Al-Khudhairi is the Curator of Modern and Contemporary Art at the Birmingham Museum of Art. She holds a Master of Arts with Distinction in Islamic Art and Archaeology from the School of Oriental and African Studies at the University of London with a Bachelor of Arts in Art History from Georgia State University. Al-Khudhairi was previously Co-Artistic Director at the Gwangju Biennale Foundation in South Korea, where she collaborated on the curation of the ninth edition of the Gwangju Art Biennale. She has also served as the Founding Director of Mathaf: Arab Museum of Modern Art in Qatar, and has held positions at the Brooklyn Museum and the High Museum of Art.

Eligibility The exhibition is open to current Sumter County residents and UWA students who are 18 years of age or older. Each artist may submit up to 3 entries. The categories include painting, photography, drawing, printmaking, textiles, mixed media, and sculpture (including stain glass, ceramics, etc). Only original designs and constructions are acceptable. No kits or commercial porcelain molds may be used. All work must have been created after March 1, 2014 or have not been previously exhibited in the SCFAC Juried Show. The exhibition committee reserves the right to reject any entry. The judge and the committee will determine selection and placement of pieces to be exhibited. Entries must be suitably mounted or framed for museum display and must include hardware necessary for hanging.
