Collard Greens / Instructions for Planting and Care

FALL \rightarrow plant until 2-3 weeks before the first frost.

SPRING \rightarrow plant 2-3 weeks before the last frost.

- > Require fun sun. Best planted in loose, fertile, well drained soil.
- ➤ Keep seeds evenly moist until they germinate, then water once a week.
- > Once plants are big enough to thin out (6-8in high), separate and transplant them.
- ➤ Plants can be harvest in roughly 6 weeks.
 - Always harvest the from the outside so inner leaves continue to produce.
 - Leaves can be harvested until plant starts to bloom.
 - Harvest your own seeds by letting plants blooms and go to seed, pull plants when the seed are starting to turn yellow—or let them dry then pull plant. Store in dry place.
